



The Junior Lesson Program at Muskego Lakes CC has been the most popular junior golf program in the Milwaukee area for most of its 43 years of existence. This program has received awards of excellence from the PGA of Wisconsin, Golf Foundation of Wisconsin and the National Golf Course Owners Association. These awards are due to many factors that include: constant changes based upon suggestions, limited class size, minimum one hour lessons (not ½ to ¾ of an hour like most programs) one teacher per 14 students, hands on individual help at each lesson, parental involvement and lessons that include playing golf at least 5 times as part of the total learning experience. Our 8 Junior Lesson Programs are available for children ages 6 to 17.

Lead instructor, Brandy Johnston is an LPGA member, as well as the golf coach for the Muskego High School boys golf team and the Franklin High School girls team.

In our continuing effort to provide the best Junior Golf program in the area, we are making some changes for the 2019 season.

#### **CHANGES FOR 2019**

While keeping the same types of classes we had last year, we are going to group them differently and hold all classes on Tuesdays - except for our NEW 5-week Friday evening Parent/Child lesson program, and our NEW PGA Junior League.

- A maximum number of registrants has been set for each class.
- The Advanced group and the High School girls will play 9 holes. All other groups will play for a designated amount of time, and can play as many holes as they wish before the time is up.
- A “helpful hints” sheet for scorekeeping will be designed over the winter and provided to all parents when they are scorekeeping.
- Parents will sign-up for scorekeeping duties via a Google doc that will be emailed to all parents closer to the program start date.
- Lesson times will have a 15 or 30-minute gap between groups to allow for a better transition between lessons.
- New roll call procedures have been established to allow more time for teaching. These will be explained to all groups on the first day of class.
- Due to July 4<sup>th</sup> being a Thursday, we will have a lesson that week.
- The Club Championship will now be for the Advanced group and High School girls ONLY. Instead of playing the last two weeks, we will use the best 3 scores of the season. The golfers with the lowest average will be the winners in their respective flights. Winners will be announced at the Parent-Child Tournament and Banquet.

## Groups & Fees for 2019

### TUESDAY'S – June 20<sup>th</sup> thru August 6<sup>th</sup>

- **Boys - Advanced:** Includes 6 nine-hole rounds of golf and 8 golf lessons. Classes have a start time of 8am. \$210.00 if you walk with your child and keep score on one or more play days. Cost if you request to opt-out of score-keeping duties: \$260.
- **Girls only entering 9<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup> grade in Sept. 2019:** A great opportunity for current high school players to prepare for the 2019 high season! *An interest in high school golf or being a current member of a high school team is NOT required.* Includes 6 nine-hole rounds of golf and 8 golf lessons. Classes are on Tuesdays at 9:30. See above schedule for details. \$210.00 if you walk with your child and keep score on one or more play days. Cost if you request to opt-out of score-keeping duties: \$260. *Girls who are not yet in 9<sup>th</sup> grade, but able to play 9-holes at a good pace may join this class.*
- **Boys - Intermediates:** Includes 5, rounds of golf on the regular course. Classes have a start time of 11am. \$185.00 if you walk with your child and keep score on one or more play days. Cost if you request to opt-out of score-keeping duties: \$235.

- **Girls only entering 3<sup>rd</sup> thru 8<sup>th</sup> grade in Sept. 2019:** Includes 5 rounds of golf on the regular course from shortened distances and 8 golf lessons. Start time is 12:30. \$185.00 if you walk with your child and keep score on one or more play days. If you request to opt-out of score-keeping duties: \$235.
- **Boys & Girls - Beginners:** for Children ages 6 to 10. Includes 5 times playing golf with shorter holes on the regular course. Classes have a start time of 2pm. \$160.00 if you walk with your child and keep score on one or more play days. Cost if you request to opt-out of score-keeping duties: \$210.
- **Pee Wee Class:**
  - For kids new to the game and between the ages of 6 and 8. Cost of \$105.00 for five lessons.
  - A five week course on Tuesday mornings from 9:30 to 11:00 starting the week of **July 9<sup>th</sup> through August 6<sup>th</sup>**.
  - Pee Wees will have a real treat learning to play golf with a specially designed system for the beginner golfer. It is called "Snag Golf." It is very hard for a younger person to swing a metal club with a small clubface and accomplish much more than poor contact and ground balls. Snag Golf is a full system with training aids. We supply the clubs that have a plastic head that is four times larger than a regular club. The balls are a smaller version of a tennis ball. This makes for ease of contact and flight. This system will be shown to you at the REQUIRED MEETING for all new registrants.

### **PARENT – CHILD LESSONS FRIDAYS (ages 10 to 17) – July 12<sup>th</sup> thru Aug. 9<sup>th</sup>**

Lessons from 5:30 to 6:30 followed by playing golf at 6:30 with a cart. \$250 per twosome.

### **NOTES – All Classes**

- Parent scoring participation is an absolute necessity for the Muskego Lakes Country Club Junior Program to be successful. This is why we charge a higher price for those kids where the parent cannot score-keep. Your assistance with this important facet of our program is greatly appreciated. Failure to show on your scoring date will prevent a foursome of children from playing on that date. **Please, you are responsible for obtaining a substitute scorer if you are unable to meet your obligation.**
- **Parents Meeting: Wednesday, May 8<sup>th</sup> or Thursday, May 16<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 PM.** One-time attendance is required for parents whose child is new to the program. Optional for parents of returning golfers who may have questions or concerns.

### **PARENT CHILD TOURNAMENT & BANQUET with AWARDS PRESENTATION, SUNDAY 8/11.**

All students will play the regular course. Beginners will play 4 holes while all other groups will play 9 holes with a shotgun start at 3:30pm. There is an additional charge for this event: Beginners w/parent or grandparent \$42, intermediates \$56 and advanced \$56. These fees include: food, soda, prizes and the parent's greens fee. The child plays FREE! Application forms will be available in July. Current HS players should speak with their coach prior to signing up.

## **PGA Junior League Golf**

PGA Junior League Golf is designed to bring a “little league” atmosphere to golf. With teams comprised of boys and girls ages 8 to 13. PGA Junior League provides a structured league environment for young golfers to compete, have fun and learn the game. Open to all boys and girls age 13 and under as of August 1, 2019.

- All players receive TWO team jersey’s, a T-shirt, Drawstring bag, Hat and Bag tag.
- 8 practices for 1 and ½ hours held on Thursdays from 5:30-7:00 beginning May 30th. There will be no practice on Thursday, June 13<sup>th</sup>. Matches begin in June and will end by July 31<sup>st</sup> to allow time for the All-Star season.
- Practice seasons to include: range time, team contests, course time and rules.
- 5-6 team matches vs other area courses, held on Sundays from 4:30 to 7:30pm. ***This could vary based on course availability for our AWAY matches.***
- Opportunity for a team to advance to post-season and all-star teams.
- All team members play in every match.
- Advanced skills not required – if your child can drive, chip or putt, we have a role on the team for him/her. Child must be able to walk 9 holes carrying their bag or using a pull cart.
- Class is limited to 24 students. We predict this will fill up fast, so sign up today!!

Total cost for this wonderful program is \$300 per child. (\$225 due to Muskego Lakes and \$75 due to the PGA of America). ### **Rules to be Followed for All Classes**

1. We ask that your child shows consideration and deposits trash into proper containers.
2. No foul language.
3. No club throwing or displays of anger.
4. No cheating, you must follow the rules of golf and count all strokes and penalties.
5. Only hit balls on the range once given permission. This helps avoid the danger of a child getting hit with a ball.
6. Never go out on the range to pick up golf balls when someone else is hitting.
7. Fix ball marks, rake sand traps and replace divots.
8. Keep up to the group in front of you.
9. Be ready to hit when it is your turn.

Discipline will result if these rules are not followed. That discipline could include: not being allowed to hit balls during a lesson for some period of time, termination of your round of golf and/or suspension of playing privileges for a period of time. If a child continues to disrupt the program, we reserve the right to terminate their involvement without refund of payment.
